RESOLUTION (R20-03)

SUBJECT: SUPPORT FOR MAMMOTH LAKES RECREATION & HUMBOLDT-

TOIYABE NATIONAL FORREST APPLICATION FOR FUNDING

FROM SIERRA NEVADA CONSERVANCY

WHEREAS: the Bridgeport Indian Colony (Colony), a federally-recognized Indian Tribe

located on the Colony's reservation in Mono County, California, with inherent sovereignty and a government-to-government relationship with the United States of America, is eligible for all rights afforded to federally-recognized tribes, with the Bridgeport Indian Colony Tribal Council (Tribal Council) as

the recognized and elected governing body of the Colony; and

WHEREAS: the Bridgeport Indian Colony supports the development and improvement of

surrounding Communities

WHEREAS: The Bridgeport Indian Colony has reviewed the project proposed by Mammoth

Lakes Recreation & Humboldt-Toiyabe National Forrest to make improvements

to the Buckeye Hot Springs/Road which will benefit historic lands, and

WHEREAS: Mammoth Lakes Recreation & Humboldt-Toiyabe National Forrest has submitted

Application for funding to the Sierra Nevada Conservancy for funding to Forrest to make improvements to the Buckeye Hot Springs/Road which will benefit

historic lands, and

WHEREAS: The Bridgeport Indian Colony SUPPORTS Mammoth Lakes Recreation &
