Smoke will be visible from various locations including Lee Vining, June Lake, Mammoth Mountain, along Bishop Creek, and near Swall Meadows.

Fire crews are taking advantage of the recent snow to help safely burn piles. These are part of ongoing thinning projects is to reduce wildfire risk for the neighboring communities.
