### **Mono Lake Ranger District**

**Roads closed:** Tioga Pass (Hwy 120 W) at Lee Vining Gate, Saddlebag Road, Hwy 108 (Sonora Pass), Hwy 89 (Monitor Pass), Hwy 4 (Ebbetts Pass) – passes closed due to recent storm, check for updates at <https://roads.dot.ca.gov/>

**Roads open:** Lundy Lake Rd., Hwy 120 E (Benton Crossing), June Lake Loop (Hwy 158), Bodie Rd. (Hwy 270),
